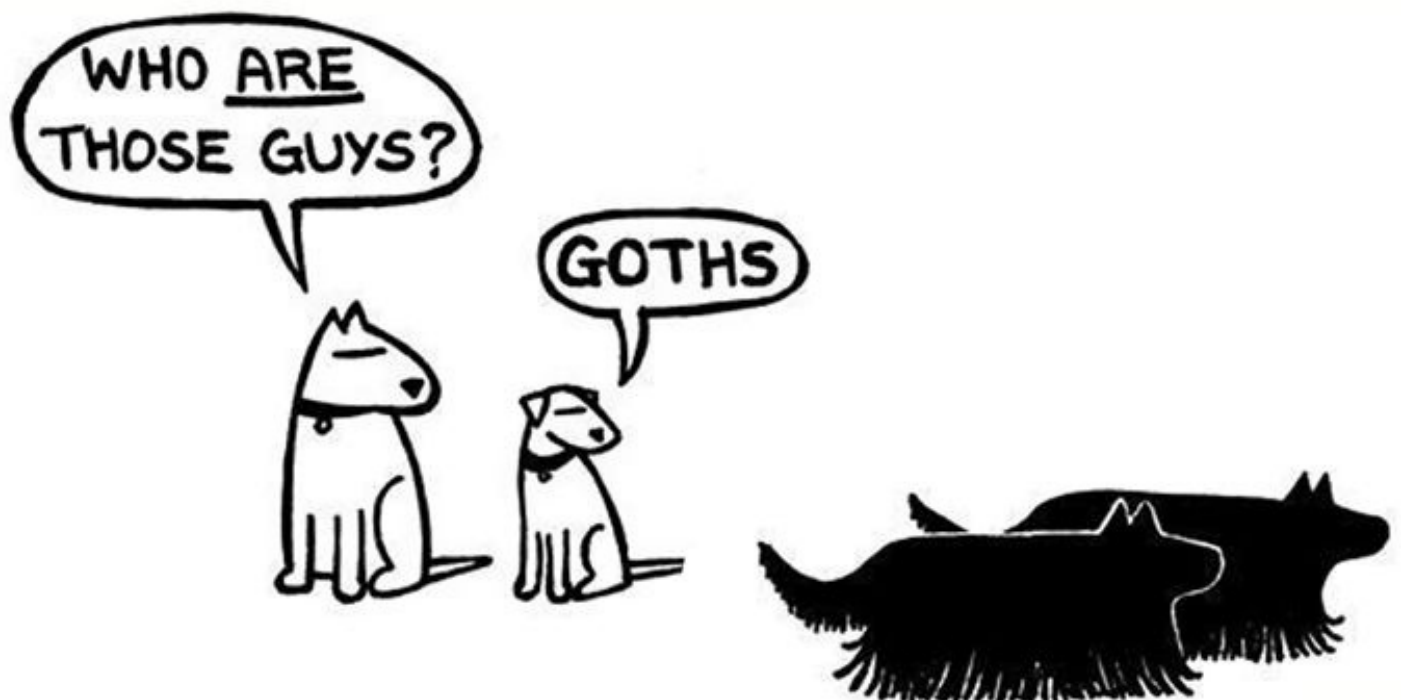
NEW LOOK FOR THE PURSUIT

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING – 3 July 2022
Venue – Falcons Ferny Grove & Districts AFL grounds, Ferny Grove

- 1.0 Meeting opened at 9.15am with Eric Smith in the chair.

6.0 Correspondence In relating to AGM:

- Office of Fair Trading (OFT) report form.

7.0 Correspondence Out relating to AGM:

- Office of Fair Trading report 2021.

Heather moved that the correspondence in and out be accepted. Seconded by Eric Smith and carried.

8.0 President's Report: Eric Smith

- 2022 has not been a good year for the club with significant rain weather events cancelling race meets from happening. The grounds have been too wet with safety a significant concern.
- The sprint meet proposed for 16 July may not go ahead at Capalaba Greyhound track with the track still in its recovery state. Should this be cancelled at Capalaba, we will look at Ferny Grove as an alternative. We need the space as we had over 90 dogs at the last sprint meet.
- Kuraby grounds have now been completed by Brisbane City Council but there are still issues with leasing arrangements and car parking. We anticipate holding a welcome meet at Kuraby on our scheduled day in August to see how it might work.
- Even though we will need to cancel all trophies for 2022 with insufficient meets, any qualifications for Titles will still be recognised.

9.0 Financial Report:

The financial report for 2021-2022 was presented by Shaaron and it was confirmed that the audit had been completed by Mirani Accountants who confirmed that a full audit was not required as our income was less than \$20,000.

Income	\$18,460.00
