There are to be NO children under the age of 16 in charge of handling dogs

Be mindful of the rope whilst on the course

Be aware of electrical cords and hoses across the grounds

Wear closed in shoes only, NO thongs, NO crocks, NO sandals

Don't stand around the gate unless your group has been called and you are the next entry

Once your dog has finished its race, exit through the designated exit gate, **NOT** the entry gate

Watch for ants and other biting insects

Keep your dogs on a short leash, and away from other dogs, especially dogs with a <u>YELLOW</u> ribbon or leash

NO extension leads/flexi leads

We recommend you crate your dog/s and ensure they are not left unsupervised whilst waiting their turn

Please be aware that a **10kmph speed limit** applies in the shared car park area.

Please keep your dogs race number on you at all times!

At the AGM the QLCA voted to join the ALCA. Why has the QLCA joined the ALCA?

- 1 The ALCA has very similar out looks to the QLCA.
- 2 The ALCA treats all Breeds of dogs as equals including cross breeds, so it doesn't matter if it is a Greyhound, Poodle, Papillion or a cross breed all dogs can obtaine the same certificates eg Lure coursing field champion, Lure courser of Merit etc
- 3 The judging system is very similar to the QLCA system
- 4 The QLCA will still retain its yearly points system, and grading points
- 5 The ALCA titles will start from next year. You will not have to start again, points gained will carry over.

Script for endurance races

These competitions are held in August and September of each year and aim to test the endurance of the highest performing dogs in each of the categories.

To be eligible for these events, dogs must attend three of the six qualifying meets. A dog must have a minimum score of 150 in each of the qualifying meetings. The top three qualifying dogs (calculated on the top three scores) are invited to compete with the next two qualifying dogs being invited as reserves.

Hope Island Cup

This is an endurance event for sighthounds. Dogs are required to run twice over a course of at least 550 metres with a 10 minute break between runs.

The 2023 winner is the Saluki, Cherie

Shanett trophy

This endurance event is for all registered breeds other than sighthounds.

The winner this year is the Peruvian Hairless, Eddie

Rouge et Noir trophy

This event is for all unregistered and mixed breeds and was won by

the Staffy X, Chewie

Fun is a Terrier shield

Endurance event for all terriers was won this year by Border Terrier, Seymour

Joshua Cup

This event is for all registered dogs that are Lure Coursers of Merit.

The winner this year in Greyhound, Bella.

Storm in a Cup

This event is for all unregistered and mixed breed dogs that are Companion of Course Merit.

The winner this year is Staffy X, Chewie

Script for the Perpetual Trophies

The perpetual trophies were donated by past members of the club to recognise outstanding achievement, on the basis of average and overall scores throughout the year.

for the most improved Unregistered/Mixed Breed goes to Indie the Greyhound X with an average score of 175 .. which is pretty good for a newtimer. This dog has a big future in Lure Coursing.

Kuraby Trophy

Top Unregistered/Mixed Breed goes to **Miley** the Beagle, with an **overall score of 1568.** A very focused dog that leads the way for the scenthounds.

Aristat Trophy

Top Registered breeds other than hounds goes to Valkyrie the Labrador with an overall score of 1259. This dog never puts a foot wrong. Powerful, keen, and relentless..everything you'd want in a working gundog.

Pepsi Memorial Trophy

Top overall score for Terriers goes to Border Terrier **Ebay** with an

overall score of 1166. With a score like this, Ebay is certainly, starting to show his talent.

Bunya Kennels Trophy

Top Terrier average score goes to Border Terrier Chloe with an average score of 171 which is a very good score for an elderly dog. Chloe has won most of the perpetual trophies in her career

Toomba Trophy


